

Guidelines for the final presentation

One of the most important goals of this winter school is to give you the possibility to learn something new and useful for your daily work. Therefore, we have opted for a “Bring your own use case” approach to the final presentation.

For the last day of the school (Friday 22nd) we have scheduled two hours (from 9 to 11) to let you present and share your use case with teachers and the other participants.

You ask you to choose one of the topics covered in the school and apply it to one of your use cases (Semantics; VREs, Data Analysis & Visualisation; Resource access tools; Cloud computing) and consider how to apply it to your work – for example the use case you described when you registered, or another one that occurred to you during the School.

Note that you can choose between working individually, or together with another person.

What you are asked to prepare and send by email within Thursday 21 January:

- a 1-2-page written report that describes what you learned from the school and how you think that your work will benefit of the topics of the school by presenting a real use case. This report will be evaluated/annotated by the teacher(s) of the corresponding topic;
- a 2-3-slides PowerPoint presentation that synthesizes the written report for a visual presentation to be held in max 5 minutes on Friday 22 January
